ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts for the 2023 CPRIT Innovations in Cancer Prevention and Research Conference VI are due by July 31, 2023. No abstracts will be considered after this deadline.

- Only abstracts submitted via the conference website will be considered.
- Submitting an abstract online DOES NOT register you to attend the conference. Create a profile and register [here](#).
- CPRIT welcomes abstracts from both current grant award recipients and other individuals or organizations. CPRIT funding is not required for abstract submission.
- A maximum of TWO abstracts may be submitted from each CPRIT grant award (e.g. PP200001). CPRIT reserves the right to limit the number of accepted abstracts.
- Abstract content must be based upon the best available evidence and should not promote any healthcare device, drug, product, or service.
- Print out and proofread the abstract preview to verify that it is complete and correct before submission. Pay special attention to scientific nomenclature, symbols, and special characters.
- The submitter must agree to the terms and conditions of the online submission agreement before submitting an abstract.
- Abstracts will be available online prior to, during, and after the conference. Access information will be posted on the conference site.
